In 2024, we will award 13 scholarships totaling \$32,000 to use to further their education. We are committed to making a difference in our community and celebrating academic achievements.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must live, work, worship or attend school in the EFCU Financial nine parish service area: East Baton Rouge, West Baton Rouge, Ascension, East Feliciana, West Feliciana, Iberville, Livingston, Point Coupee, St. Helena.
- Applicant must be a 2024 graduating high school senior.
- Applicant must plan to enroll in an accredited college, university or trade school in the EFCU Financial nine parish service area: East Baton Rouge, West Baton Rouge, Ascension, East Feliciana, West Feliciana, Iberville, Livingston, Point Coupee, St. Helena.
- Applicant must write an essay, **500 words or less**, answering the following question: *Credit unions are known for giving back to the communities they serve. In addition to offering scholarships to deserving high school seniors, the EFCU Financial Foundation makes a charitable donation to many worthy organizations in the Greater Baton Rouge Area. If you could make a donation to a worthy local organization, which one would you choose and why?*

HOW TO APPLY ONLINE

1. Complete pages 1 & 2 of the official application and submit an official copy of school transcript with signature of high school authority.
2. Application and supporting document must be **SUBMITTED by Friday, April 19, 2024.**
3. Submit application and transcript online.
4. Incomplete applications will be disqualified and filed with no action.

HOW TO APPLY BY MAIL

1. Complete the first page of the official application and include an official copy of school transcript with signature of high school authority.
2. Complete the essay portion (see topic information under Scholarship Requirements above):
 - Typed scholarship essay: Double spaced, Times New Roman or Arial font, 12 pt. font size, with one-inch margins
3. Application and transcript must be **RECEIVED by Friday, April 19, 2024.**
